Returned Checks: Any person writing a check on an account with insufficient funds will be charged a returned check fee of \$50.00.

Post Entries: Post entries will be accepted after September 4th, 2026, up to 5:00 PM the day before the class, with an additional fee of \$150/horse. All classes must be entered the day prior by 5 PM. No exceptions. No adds at the gate.

Exception: Cattle Classes may NOT be added after Deadline (9/4/26)

WRHA Membership: A current 2026 WRHA Membership is required to show in the WRHA World Championship Ranch Horse Classes.

WRHA Walk/Trot Card is required to show in Youth or Amateur Walk/Trot. NO CROSS-OVERS INTO 3 GAITED CLASSES PERMITTED.

A Walk-Trot Card is not required to show in the Open Walk/Trot and/or Walk/Trot PLUS

LEADLINE: Exhibitors are only permitted to show in the leadline division. No cross entries permitted. Leadline may be asked to jog, if appropriate, at the judge's discretion.

Refunds: Refunds may be granted, **provided a written veterinarian or physician certificate is received with the refund request.** If proper documentation is provided, a refund may be granted on entries, less a \$50.00 office fee. No Refunds will be issued for "No Shows". NO REFUNDS for scratched classes. Credit card fees are non-refundable.

Bedding: Shavings must be purchased with entry or at the Horse Show Office. No outside shavings are permitted.

Awards: Exhibitors must pick up their awards prior to leaving the show. Awards not picked up may be shipped to the exhibitor after the show. The cost for shipping awards will be shipping cost + \$50.00.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash at all times and shall be secured and not roam free during the horse show.

Stalls: Stalls will be assigned based on the order in which the **paid stall reservations are received.**

Premium stalls will be reserved for sponsors & VIP's. Stall location may be requested on a first-come, first-served basis. Requests may not be able to be accommodated.

Ties: All ties will be broken by the Tie Breaker Judge. The tie-breaker judge will be announced each day.

Protests: All protests must be made in writing by the end of the show, and a protest fee of \$100.00 must accompany the protest. If the protest is found to be valid, the \$100.00 fee will be refunded.

Entry Forms: All entries must be submitted on the forms provided on the WRHA website or by the show secretary. All contestants must check out at the show office or leave an open check for completion of entries. Back numbers will not be issued without payment.

Gate Calls: A 2-minute gate call will be enforced. Please make every effort to be at the gate when your class is called. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready at the gate when their class enters the arena. Contestants needing extra time for tack changes, etc. must notify the show personnel before gate call. The gate will be closed after 2 minutes. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter the class.

Freestyle Reining: Riders will provide their own music (preferably on a phone, which will be given to the announcer. This class may be entered as a single rider or a pair. Required elements include, but are not limited to: 2 runs the length of the arena, 1 run ½ length of arena, 3 stops, 2 sets of spins – each direction, each set consisting of 2 complete spins, 1 back with a minimum of 5 backward steps. Each entry will be limited to 3 minutes.

WRHA Invitational Classes: Entry in these classes requires an invitation from WRHA. Invitations are sent to any exhibitors placing 1st or 2nd in the respective classes during the calendar period from the conclusion of the 2025 World Show to August 1st, 2026. There is no entry fee to enter these classes. The WRHA invitation covers the class entry fee only. Additional fees may apply (drug fee, office fee, etc.)

- **All World and Reserve World Champions will win a custom belt buckle**
- **Random awards drawn for each class from non-winners**
- **High Point Winners in Youth (combined), Amateur (combined) & Open (combined) will receive a custom saddle**
- **High Point Winners in individual divisions will receive custom awards**
- **High Point Dry Work is limited to the exhibitors not showing in cattle classes**
- **Sportsmanship Award-** Will be given to an individual (youth or adult) for exemplary sportsmanship throughout the show. Nominations may be made to the Horse Show Managers (Tim Jedra/Carolyn Dobbins)
